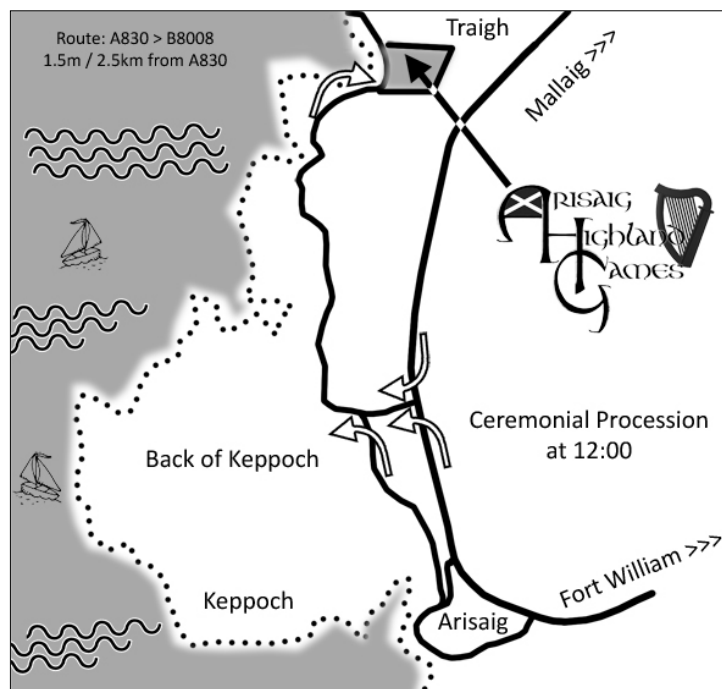
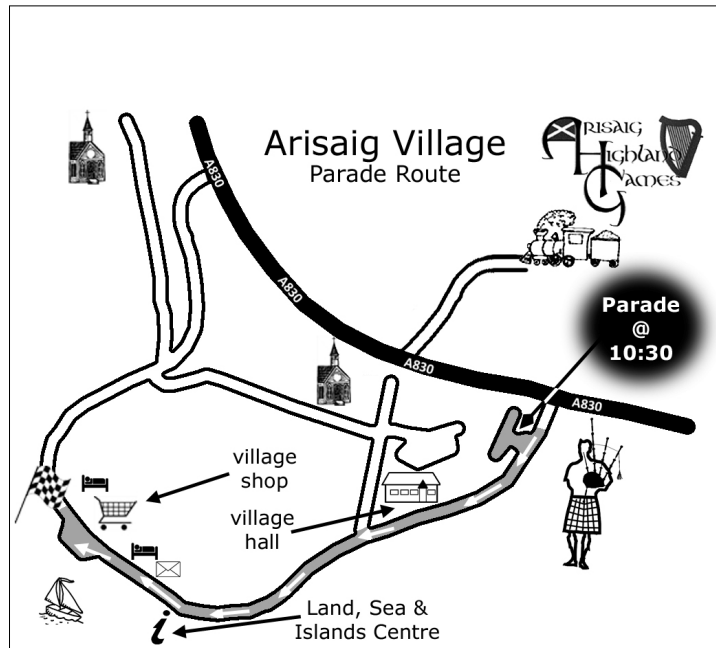
For those who prefer to be less metric: Arisaig lies on the historic 'Road to the Isles', also known as the A830 which leads from Fort William to Mallaig. The village is just about 35 miles east of Fort William and 10 miles south of Mallaig.

Getting to Arisaig by rail:

Arisaig railway station is on the West Highland Line which connects the village to Mallaig, Fort William & Glasgow.

Getting to the parade:

The village parade on the morning of the Games begins at the eastern end of the village at 10:30am. The parade route moves down the main street finishing outside the village shop with views out across the bay.



Getting to the Games:

The Games are located at Traigh Farm, around two miles north of the village, by the golf course. Please note there is no regular transport service to Traigh. The easiest way to make the 2.5 mile journey is by car. Take the A830 Fort William to Mallaig road, and turn left half a mile north of Arisaig on to the B8008, scenic coastal route. There is a golf course sign at this junction. Drive for about one mile until you reach the beaches of Traigh. The Games are held in the field beside the Golf course and car parking is available in the field adjacent to the arena.
