

# The Boisdale Prize

## Competition Guidelines

1. All elements of the competition are subject to the general Competitor Rules as published by Arisaig Games. See: <http://www.arisaighighlandgames.co.uk/assets/files/PDFs/Texts-5a-CompetitorRules-01b.pdf>
2. All entries are received under those rules and these guidelines.
3. The area of eligibility is 'Local', however, entrants who do not fall within the definition of local in the competitor rules, but are a member of an art group which does, are welcome to enter.
4. The competition runs with the following age ranges and prizes:
  - a. Juvenile 0-10 yrs £15, £10, £5;
  - b. Junior 2 11-13 yrs £40, £20, £10;
  - c. Junior 1 14-17 yrs £75, £40, £20;
  - d. Adult 18+ yrs £200.
5. Entries are individual. No group, such as school, entries are permitted, although publicity may be available through school art departments or other groups.
6. Entries are restricted to one per person.
7. 2011 competition themes are:
  - a. Juveniles and Juniors: **Lochaber: The Past in the Present.**
  - b. Adults: **Arisaig Highland Games: An Impression.**
8. All entries are to be submitted on:
  - a. Juvenile Paper or canvas, no less than A5, no greater than A4;
  - b. Junior 2 Paper or canvas, A4;
  - c. Junior 1 Paper or canvas, no less than A4, no greater than A3 ;
  - d. Adult Canvas, no less than A4, no greater than A3.
  - e. Framing No framing, matting, wrapping, or encapsulating is permitted.
9. Methods and media
  - a. Format Originals. No prints of artwork are permitted.
  - b. Graphics Paint or drawing.
  - c. Main media Paint, pencil, charcoal, pen or crayon.
  - d. Other media such as collage or found objects, may be used appropriately.
10. Schedule:
  - a. Juniors and Juveniles: **Submission** by 1pm at the Exhibitions Tent on the day, or to; Mallaig Art Gallery, Mallaig. PH41 4QS, by Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2011;  
Note that work submitted by post may be hung in Mallaig Art Gallery prior to the competition.
  - b. Adults: **Registration** before 12pm at Exhibitions Tent; **Submission** before 2:45pm at Exhibitions Tent.  
**Creation** must be on the day on blank canvas, and: on the games park, within the confines of the fence, or; from the beach or roadside between the games park and the boatshed.
  - c. Attendance Although junior and juvenile work can be submitted beforehand by post, all artists must be in attendance at the Games for their work to be entered in the competition.
11. Post competition,
  - a. placed entries will be retained by Arisaig Highland Games until a copy can be made and will then be returned to the artist;
  - b. unplaced entries must be collected by 4:30pm or may be disposed of.

- 12.** Copyright for placed entries is co-assigned to Arisaig Highland Games, who may use the images for any purpose deemed appropriate.
- 13.** Arisaig Games cannot accept any liability arising from the loss or damage to any entry.
- 14.** All entries must be signed in the image area.
- 15.** All entries must have the title on the back of the image, even if it is titled 'untitled'.
- 16.** All entries must have the artist's name, age group, address, telephone no., and email address written on the back. For Juveniles and Juniors this must be countersigned by a parent or guardian. Attached notes are not permitted.
- 17.** All entries are made with the permission to use a photograph of the artist in publicity. If a parent or guardian of a Junior or Juvenile prefers not to have their child photographed, they must make this explicit by marking "No Publicity" alongside the details above.
